

Jr. Counselors 2019

- All Jr. Counselors must attend pre-camp training. This is an important time for necessary training and bonding with fellow counselors. Jr. Counselors have two options:
 - If they want to become a certified Red Cross Lifeguard, they must arrive between June 18th -20th. They will also receive an additional \$100 bonus for becoming a life guard.
 - For all others, they must arrive by June 24th.
 - Pre-camp ends on June 27th, and the first day of camp is June 28th.
 - * Unfortunately, we can't provide transportation services to camp, unless arriving into Plattsburgh, New York (by plane, bus or train). For departure, we can provide transportation to Montreal or Burlington, VT, airports, or take the bus home with the campers at no charge.

- Jr. Counselors must work at camp for either 4, 5 or 7 weeks, and must follow our standard session dates.
 - 4 weeks – June 28th to July 26th.
 - 5 weeks – July 12th to August 17th (still required to attend pre-camp)
 - 7 weeks – June 28th to August 17th

- Jr. Counselor pay is as follows (room and board is covered):
 - 4 weeks – \$475
 - 5 weeks – \$600
 - 7 weeks – \$900*\$100 bonus for those who are certified lifeguards

- Jr. Counselors must be 17 before camp begins (June 28th). Unfortunately, no exceptions.

- Jr. Counselors are expected to assist or possibly lead activities at camp (they will always be accompanied by at least one other counselor over the age of 18).

- For those who don't meet all of the requirements, we would love to have them come back as a CIT. **Second year CIT's will receive a 75% discount from standard tuition.**
