

# CAMP JEANNE D'ARC GIVES BACK



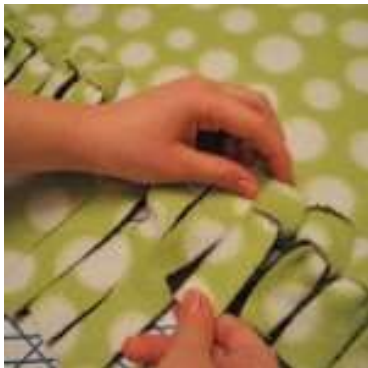
Every Sunday Campers will have the choice to help with a service project at camp. Here are some examples of projects we have done in the past.
